Tonj needs help from NGOs but with location and other problems. **We officially started in October, 2011 with certification of NGO.**

We have found Mango tree is food supply when it is also source of revenue and that is why we started business of **distributing Mango seedling**. With constant visit of site we communicated with resident and found the needs of education and we developed our business to **Himango Village project** which is on progress.

With their culture and method, we are trying to provide residents needs, so they can independently stand on their own feet.

Without stopping from **dreaming** and **hoping** but making it **realization** is **Himango's direction**.

After independence of South Sudan, Himango is the first Korean NGO to receive **international NGO certificate** from South Sudan government and for comprehensive partnership with Tonj South County, we signed **MOU** in October, 2011.

Also for constant activity of Himango, We have received forty-thousand square yard in August, 2011 and five-hundred thousand square yard in June, 2012 as Himango Village site without any cost.

Himango tries to do business that can be developed even it is one time help. Mango seedling distribution and Himango Village business, we look for goals of self-support/children-support/income-increase/improvement of environment. <Himango Village> has **complex education center** for resident's education, **relevant facility system** for basic living, **Mango nursery, farm, and factory** for agriculture business. Himango Village business will improve basic living condition such as food/water/sanitation. And with education of kindergarden and elementary with vocational education which will help self-supporting of residents and these self-support is **continuance possibility business corresponds with UN's MDGs**.

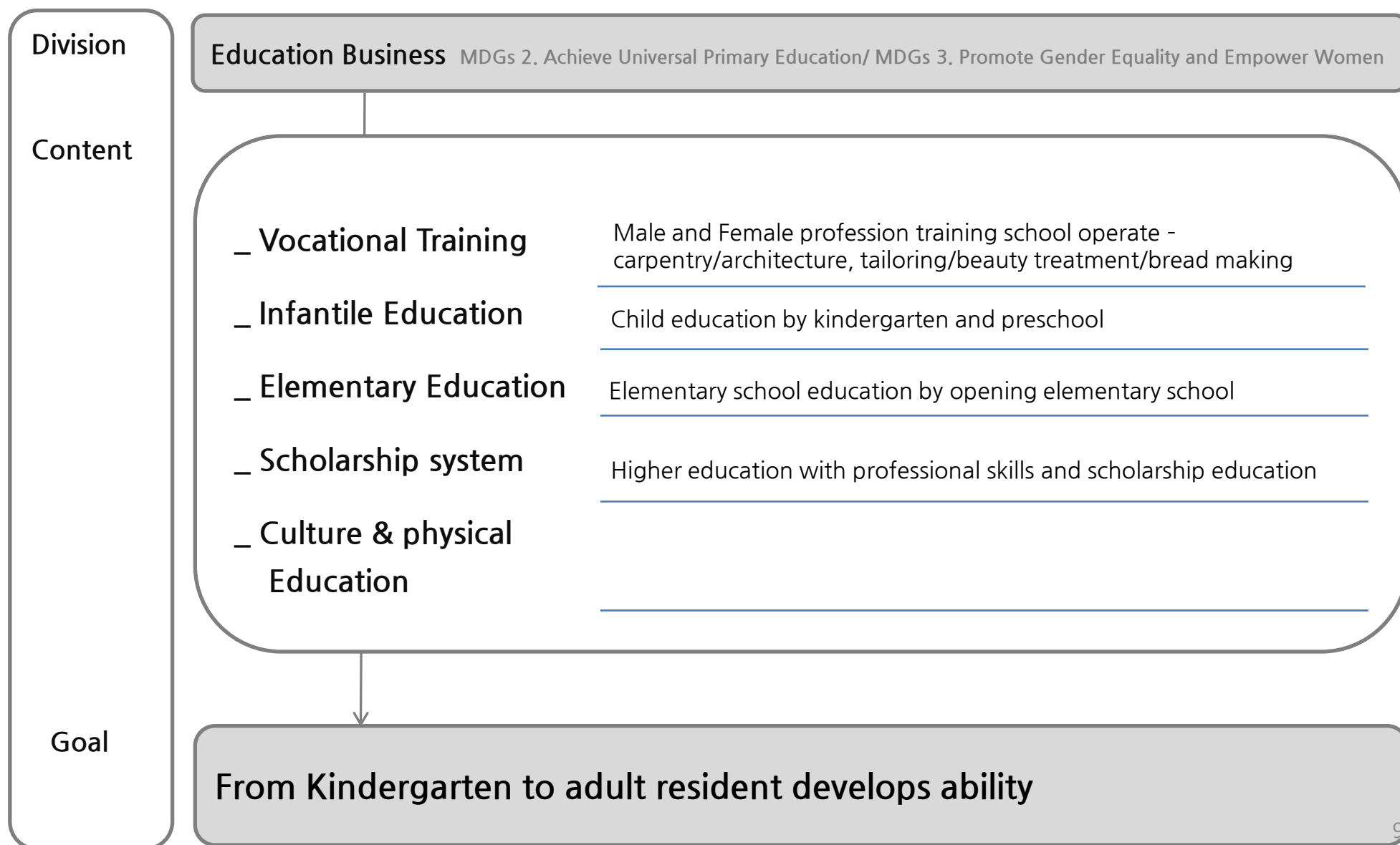

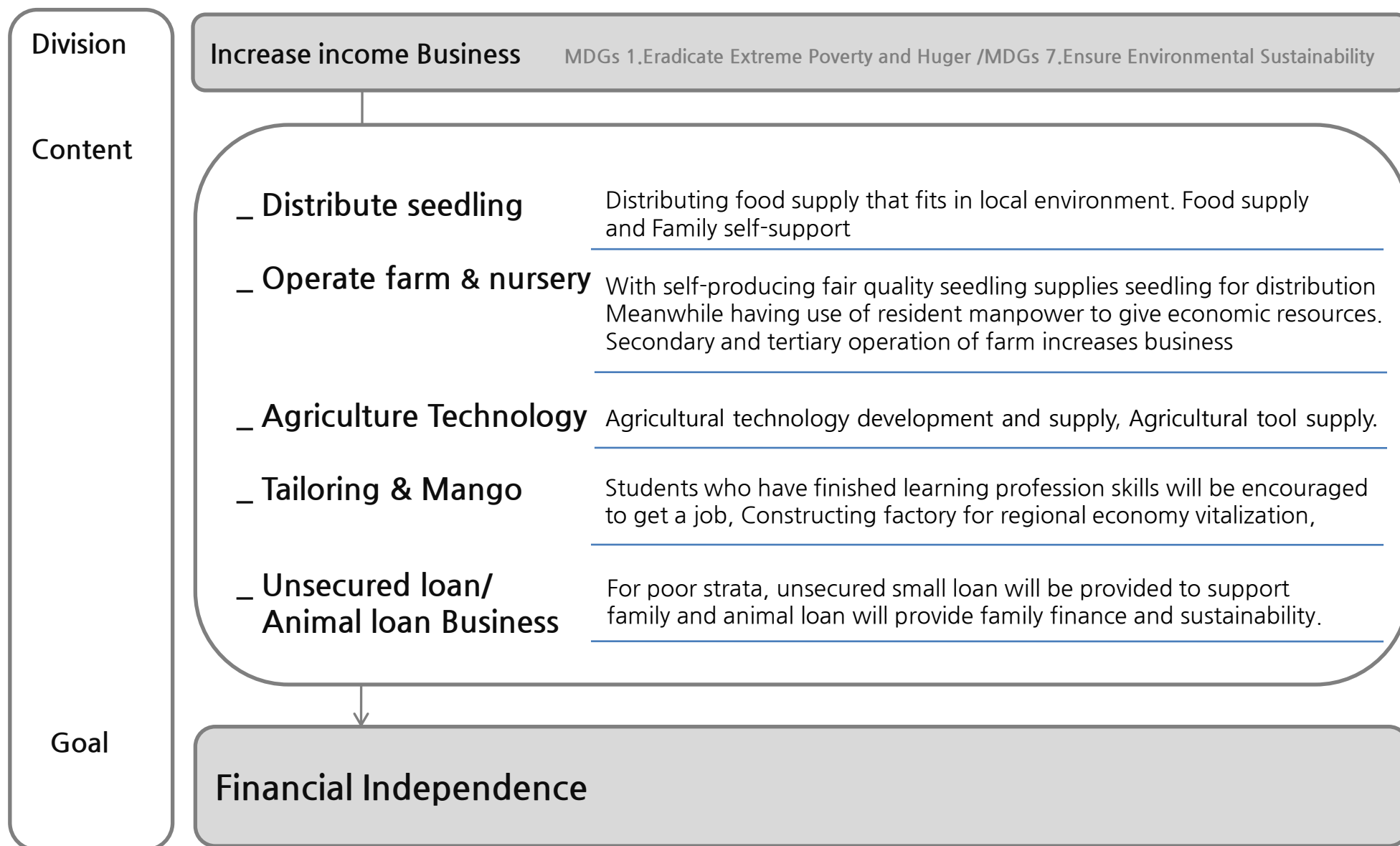

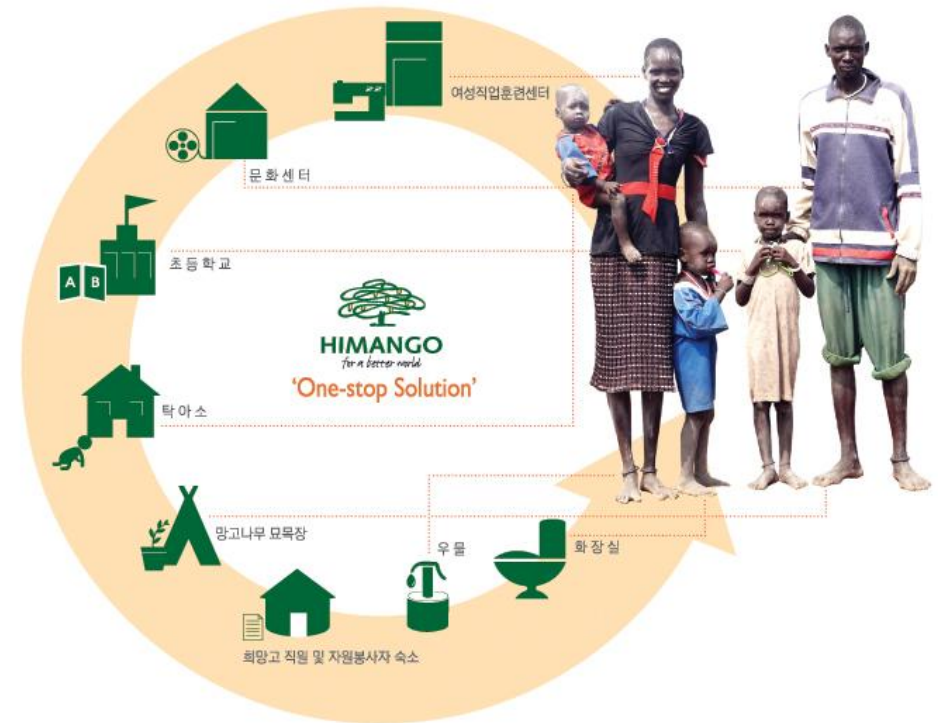
Residential area environment improvement and develop self-support ability

Himango supports centrally in **Tonj Town** Payam, **Tonj South** County, **Warrap** State, **South Sudan** by distribute of Mango seedling, complex education center, and Himango village business which develops residents capability and sustainability.

Mango tree lives for hundred years after planted. Since South Sudan have barren soil, this Mango tree is valuable food supply and income. With Mango nursery and farm, we are planning to develop fine quality seed to make them be actual resources to residents.

Women vocational training school, Men vocational training school, Kindergarten, Elementary school, Library, food facility, Mango nursery and farm, Well, restroom will be in part of Himango Village. Himango Village is including child to parents and all family to get education in one place which is 'One-Stop Solution'.



By supporting the poor strata to get a job through education and encouraging them to stand on their own feet, is correspondences with UN MDGs.

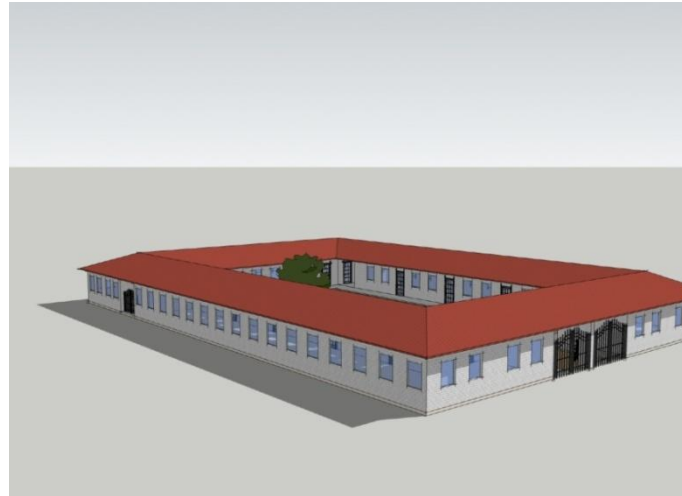

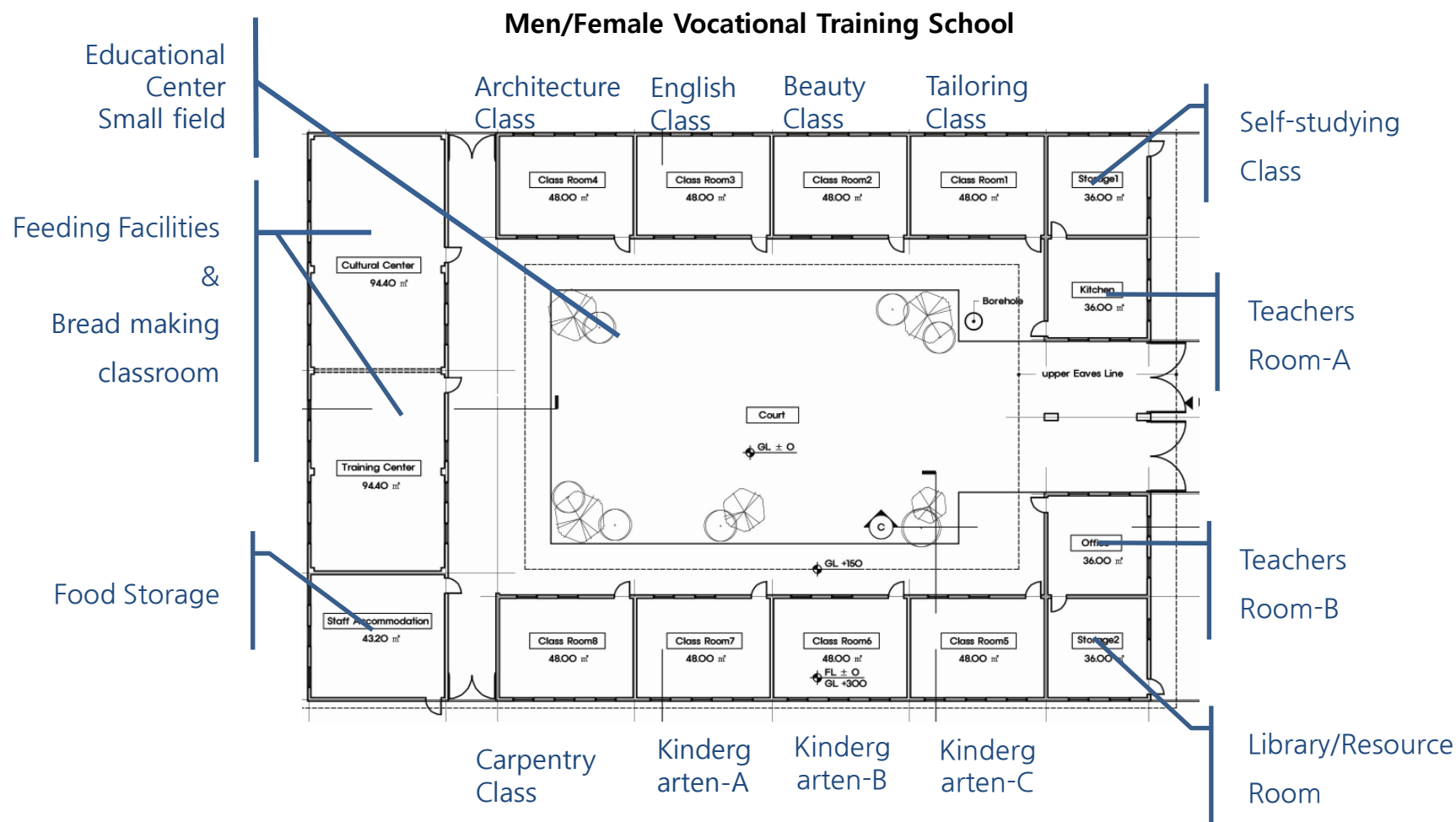
Regular class for kindergarten and tailoring class for women vocational training school started.

1. Women Vocational School officially opens
 - Tailoring class, English& Math class, Sanitation class, Agriculture class, Anger management class, etc.
 2. Himango Kindergarten Officially opens
 - 5-7, three class of each having 35 which totals up to 105 - Library and resource room will be constructed.
 3. Mango tree planting & Agriculture Business
 - Distribute of Mango trees to residents and teaching
 - Constructing two Mango Tree Street - Joint business with South Sudan and South Tonj Government
 - Mango Factory Business - Poultry farming
 4. HV Constructing Business
 - Food facilities repair, Business site extension, and Farm business extension

Women tailoring class work for Kindergarten Students

In Africa they think sense of belonging very important such as uniform and backpack.

They can buy better bag and uniform when they go to city but Himango Village ask for self-sufficiency as principle.

Also if they feel mother's love we
believe child will grow better.

Kindergarten Childs will have their hope, dream, and
love of their mom in this bag. After finishing up
producing bag, uniform for kindergarten will begin.



2014 Himango Village is... [Women school_ English Class]

Mothers who have heard about English class were filled and we made extra class for them.

Thirty students with beginning of the class increased to two classes of thirty students each. Not only woman listens but also man students from our carpentry and architecture are listening together. As time goes on basic math class will be grafted into English class.

As mother is listening to the class, child is looking after his younger sister. With knowing importance of education, mother decides to send her child to kindergarten. Their future seems to be brighter than before.



2014 Himango Village is...[Planting trees and creating Mango street]

Our employee finds Mango Tree Street every day and gives water and manure.

As South Tonj County government requested us to make four streets of Mango Tree, South Tonj Street will be filled with green.

During dry season our employee will give water and manure every day. Once it branches out Mango tree lives for hundred year with twenty meter high and provide delicious fruit as residents are expecting.
